Our declaw surgery includes:

- 1. A pre-anesthetic assessment will be performed as part of the dental procedure. A full wellness exam—is required for all patients within 90 days of the procedure.
- 2. Gas anesthesia using isofluorane.
- 3. Pulse oximeter monitoring of oxygen level and heart rate.
- 4. An injection of pain medication (Buprenorphine) that will last a total of 72 hours.
- 5. The surgery itself.
- 6. Pain medication/anti-inflammatory (Metacam) while in the hospital and to go home.
- 7. Antibiotic injection of Convneia.

A complete physical exam will be performed on your pet prior to the surgical procedure if it has been longer than 90 days since the last exam. However, this may not identify all systemic or metabolic problems. For this reason, we highly recommend doing a pre-anesthetic blood panel for pets of any age.

* These options below may not be required for your pet depending on their age, however we do recommend them for the safety and comfort of your pet. By checking the box next to the option you want you are asking that we perform that service. Please let us know if you have any questions.

■ MICROCHIP \$39.50

Although this can be installed at any time, it involves a fairly large needle so if done while your pet is under anesthesia and already getting pain medication, the procedure is more comfortable. Our microchip includes lifelong registration.

ELIZABETHAN COLLAR \$7.75-\$12.75

SOFT COLLAR \$11.06-\$14.75

This is the collar that goes around your pets neck to help prevent them from licking or chewing at the incision sites. Not all pets need this but it is handy to have just in case.

■ IV FLUIDS \$89.75

The IV catheter provides quick access to the veins case of an emergency. The fluid helps regulate blood pressure, protects the kidneys and liver, and prevents dehydration. They also help your pet during the recovery period from anesthesia during the period after the anesthesia. This is strongly recommended for all pets and **is required for pets age 7 years and older.**

PRE ANESTHETIC BLOOD TESTING \$180.00 - \$200.00 We run a very thorough test of approximately 35 different things, including a CBC for anemia and white blood cell problems, testing for liver, kidney, electrolyte problems, diabetes, thyroid levels and many other things. This is an option if your pet is under 7 years old and is required for pets 7 years and older.
SEDATIVES TO GO HOME \$15.75 In order to keep your pet calmer during the 2 week recuperation period we can send home sedatives.
I understand that some risks always exist with anesthesia and/ or surgery and that I am encouraged to discuss any concerns I have about those risks with the attending veterinarian before the procedure(s) is/are initiated.
I understand that the attending veterinarian will make every effort to contact me regarding treatment in the case of unforeseen emergencies. If unable to contact me, the staff may or may not have my permission to proceed with life sustaining procedures.
