Our dental prophy cleaning and polishing includes the following:

1. A pre-anesthetic assessment will be performed as part of the dental procedure. A full wellness exam is required for all patients within 90 days of the procedure.

- 2. IV Fluids
- 3. Gas anesthesia using isofluorane.
- 4. Pulse oximeter monitoring of oxygen level and heart rate.
- 5. Ultrasonic cleaning and polishing of the teeth.
- 6. Oral exam while under anesthesia by the doctor.

\*These options below may not be required for your pet depending on their age, however we do recommend them for the safety and comfort of your pet. By checking the box next to the option you want you are asking that we perform that service. Please let us know if you have any questions.

## PRE ANESTHETIC BLOOD TESTING \$180.00-\$200.00

We run a very thorough test of approximately 35 different things, including a CBC for anemia and white blood cell problems, testing for liver, kidney, electrolyte problems, diabetes, thyroid levels and many other things. This is an option if your pet is under 7 years old and **is required for pets 7 years and older**.

## **EXTRACTIONS \$39.75-\$199.50**

These are done only if the doctor determines that they are needed. It is best for us to have authorization now so that we do not have to keep your pet under anesthesia while we are trying to reach you on the phone. The cost can vary greatly due to the difficulty of the extraction. There may be additional charges for antibiotics, pain medication, nerve blocks and gum suture depending on the severity of extractions.

\*Please Note: If the doctor finds that the dental disease is more extensive than anticipated then the dental may be upgraded to a level 2 dental that includes full mouth radiographs which will increase the cost. The doctor may find the dental disease to be extensive based on a number of findings and will make every attempt to call you and discuss this before upgrading, however because the pet is under anesthesia if we cannot get ahold of you at the phone number you provide we will move forward in treatment.

I understand that some risks always exist with anesthesia and/ or surgery and that I am encouraged to

discuss any concerns I have about those risks with the attending veterinarian before the procedure(s) is/are initiated.

I understand that the attending veterinarian will make every effort to contact me regarding treatment in the case of unforeseen emergencies. If unable to contact me, the staff may or may not have my permission to proceed with life sustaining procedures. By giving my permission I accept any charges associated with treatment and procedures performed.
